What is the Citizen Review Committee (CRC)?

The eleven-member CRC is appointed by Portland City Council to:

- Gather community concerns about Portland Police services;
- Develop policy recommendations to address patterns of problems with Portland Police services and conduct;
- Review and advise the Independent Police Review and the Portland Police Bureau's Internal Affairs division on the complaint handling process;
- Hear appeals from complainants and officers, and publicly report their findings.

What is the Independent Police Review (IPR)?

IPR is an impartial oversight agency under the authority of the independently elected City Auditor, created to improve police accountability, promote higher standards of police services, and increase public confidence.
