NPDES 1200-C Permit Requirements



Restoring, maintaining, and enhancing the quality of Oregon's water.

Authorization

ORS 468B.050 and OAR 340-045-15(2) -33(10)(i)

SOURCES COVERED BY THIS PERMIT:

Construction activities (including clearing, grading, excavation, materials or equipment staging and stockpiling) that will disturb one or more acres and may discharge to surface waters or conveyance systems leading to surface waters of the state.

Schedule A.1. Registering New Construction Activities

The Application must include:

- i. A DEQ-approved application form;
- ii.One paper copy and one electronic copy (PDF)
 of an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan
 (ESCP);
- iii. A Land Use Compatibility Statement (LUCS) indicating that the proposed activities are compatible with the local government's acknowledged comprehensive plan; and iv. Applicable permit fees.

A.5. Authorized Non-Stormwater Discharges

- e. Construction dewatering activities (including groundwater dewatering and well drilling discharge associated with the registered construction activity), provided that:
 - i. the water is land applied in a way that results in complete infiltration with no potential to discharge to a surface water of the state, <u>or</u>
 - ii. Best Management Practices (BMPs) or an approved treatment system is used to ensure compliance with discharge and water quality requirements;

9.d. Stormwater Treatment Systems.

- •When a treatment system is used:
 - Must submit an operation and maintenance (O&M) plan <u>before</u> operating the treatment system.

Plan must include:

- system schematic,
- location of system,
- location of inlet,
- location of discharge,
- discharge dispersion device design, and a
- sampling plan and monitoring frequency.

9.d. Stormwater Treatment Systems.

- When a treatment system is used:
 - •The O&M plan must be approved <u>before</u> operating the treatment system.
 - The treatment system must be operated and maintained according to manufacturer's specifications.
