Below is a matrix of the Networks PEG topics and meetings with the corresponding Periodic Review Task, Portland Plan Policy and/or Portland Plan Action.

There are a number of Policies and Actions that do not have a specific Networks PEG topic presentation or discussion. One example is Safe Routes to School (T-13 and T-14, A-38). This work will be done by staff for the Discussion Draft and reviewed by the PEGs and the public. We already have a proposed Safe Routes to School Policy developed by PBOT staff. A similar item is Broadband in Neighborhoods (A-105). A Broadband Plan was adopted by council; staff will integrate the report into the Comp Plan's Discussion Draft for PEG and public review. Also, some of the transportation related policies and actions will be developed in the Centers, Residential, or Infrastructure Equity PEGs.

Also, the Portland Plan Checklist will be a constant reminder to refer to The Portland Plan and Equity Framework for all of these topics.
