Guides and Magnets (included in doorhanger bags, but may be ordered separately)

- Door Hanger Bags:** Clear door hanger bags contain one Multifamily Composting Guide and one refrigerator magnet. These are great for program start-up. Quantity

- Kitchen Pail:** Please note: the City of Portland has a limited number of 2 gallon kitchen pails available free of charge on a first-come, first-serve basis for multifamily residents.
 - Property managers may place one order, not to exceed the number of units in the building(s).
 - Each pail will include a composting guide and magnet.

The City has no plans to order more pails once the current stock of pails is depleted; however technical assistance and educational materials (brochures, signs and magnets) for both recycling and food scrap collection will continue to be available free of charge.
