Using maps, policy analysis, community based research, and other tools, Coalition for a Livable Future's Regional Equity Atlas project assesses how well different populations across the four-county Portland-Vancouver metro region can access key resources necessary for meeting their basic needs and advancing their health and well-being.

By illuminating the region's geography of opportunity, the Regional Equity Atlas is a powerful tool for promoting greater regional equity. It can be used to inform a wide range of planning, policy, and investment decisions, such as where to locate new housing, transit, parks, services, infrastructure, and other amenities, and where to most effectively target public and private investments.
