How to prepare your meds for the drop box

Please consolidate all pills by putting them into a sealed sandwich baggy if you have a large amount to dispose of.

Make sure that liquids are in a tightly sealed, leak proof container.

NO SHARPS!



Acceptable items for deposit

Prescription medications and samples,
all over-the-counter medications,
vitamins,
pet medications,
medicated ointments, and
liquid medication in leak proof containers



Items NOT acceptable for deposit

Thermometers,
sharps/syringes,
IV bags,
bloody or infectious waste,
hydrogen peroxide,
aerosol cans,
inhalers, or
EpiPens
