Update on Drug Free Impact Areas <p>Mike Boyer, Crime Prevention Program Coordinator with the City of Portland, and Billy Prince, Deputy District Attorney, Multnomah County, will update us on the Drug Free Impact Areas that were established in June 2011. In the first six months, 254 people were excluded from the three areas police saw as hot spots: Old Town Chinatown, a neighboring portion of downtown Portland and a large swath around Lloyd Center. Mr. Boyer and Mr. Prince will discuss how these areas are working, the factors which get people excluded from the areas, and what happens to individuals once they are excluded.</p>	3:30-4:00
