



Heritage Trees of Portland

YELLOWWOOD (*Cladrastis kentukea*) FABACEAE

- Native to southwestern U.S.
- Height seldom exceeds 80'.
- Compound leaves with 5-9 leaflets that alternate on leaf stem (rare for family).
- Flower looks like white wisteria. Clusters 12" long. Tend to appear in alternate years. 3" seed pods look like pea pods.
- Heartwood is bright yellow.
- Fall foliage is yellow.
- Uncommon in Portland. #132 is largest of five in a row.
