



Heritage Trees of Portland

SAUCER MAGNOLIA (*Magnolia x soulangiana*)
MAGNOLIACEAE

- Hybrid created in France ca. 1820. A cross between *M. denudata* and *M. liliiflora*. Many cultivars exist.
- Height does not exceed 50', spread does.
- Leaves have smooth margins, about 6" long.
- Flowers are tulip-like at first, then open to "saucer" shape of 6"; 9 petals. Fruit matures to scarlet seeds.
- Fall color insignificant.
- Common in Portland.
