



Heritage Trees of Portland

SITKA SPRUCE (*Picea sitchensis*) PINACEAE

- Native to Pacific coast from south Alaska to north California.
- In the wild can reach over 300'.
- Foliage evergreen, needle-like, sharp, whitish beneath but green on top.
- Seed cones 2-4" long, tan with papery scales.
- Bark is thin and scaly.
- Wood has good strength-to-weight ratio; used for musical instruments and the Spruce Goose.
- Not common in Portland (too far from coast).
