



## Heritage Trees of Portland

### AUSTRIAN PINE (*Pinus nigra*) PINACEAE

- Native to eastern Europe.
- Height can exceed 100'.
- Needles 2 to a bundle, 3-5.5" long, stiff, dark green and "sooty" looking.
- Seed cones 2-4" long, can be in whorls of up to 6.
- Bark can have pink tinge on the plates between fissures.
- Common in Portland. This Heritage Tree is believed to have been planted sometime in the late 19th century by Henry Miller, one of Portland's first florists.
