



Heritage Trees of Portland

GIANT SEQUOIA (*Sequoiadendron giganteum*) CUPRESSACEAE

- Native to western slopes of Sierra Nevadas.
- Height can exceed 275', circumference >90' (greatest in the world).
- Needles are gray-green, sharp, cord-like, surround the shoot.
- Seed cones 1.5-3.5" long, ovoid.
- Rather common in Portland. Can easily be spotted by height and pointy top. Many planted ca. 1900.
