



Heritage Trees of Portland

BIGLEAF LINDEN (*Tilia platyphyllos*) TILIACEAE

- Native to Europe and southwest Asia.
- Height can reach 135'.
- Leaves 5-7" long with tiny hairs on both sides, heart-shaped.
- Flowers pale yellow in cluster, suspended from a leaf-like bract; earliest of this genus to flower (late May/early June); seeds round and fuzzy on surface.
- Like all in genus, flowers loved by bees.
- Fairly common in Portland - in older neighborhoods. #62 is gigantic.
