<i>Barbur Concept Plan and Southwest Corridor Plan</i> Denver Igarra from Portland Bureau of Transportation and Crista Gardner from Metro will introduce the Barbur Concept Plan and explain its connection to Metro's Southwest Corridor Plan. The Barbur Concept Plan is a land use strategy to leverage regional investment in High Capacity Transit in SW Portland. The SW Corridor Plan integrated local land use plans with future transportation, parks and natural area improvements that support future high capacity transit and with other goals for the corridor. Denver and Crista will provide key dates for the BAC to plug into the process and give input into Metro's SW Corridor process.	<i>6:50</i>
