Transportation System Plan Update: Classification Policies For several months representatives from the Bicycle, Pedestrian and Freight Advisory committees have been working with PBOT staff to identify potential conflicts with other modes created by updating the city's classifications policies for bicycle transportation. The classification policies are to be updated to reflect the changes adopted in 2010 by City Council in the <i>Portland Bicycle Plan for 2030</i> . PBOT staff will present the results of that work and participate in a discussion about committee recommendations. PBOT is seeking the BAC's recommendations for incorporation into the TSP.	<i>6:10</i>
