Planning for on-street parking in the CEID: What you should know

What is the district doing to improve on-street parking?

The Central Eastside Industrial Council (CEIC) has a Transportation and Parking Advisory Committee (TPAC) that focuses on issues regarding parking, freight, traffic, public transit, bicycles, pedestrians or any issue that impacts a business's ability to load, unload, park or move in and out of the district. If you are a part of the district, the TPAC is eager to address your needs and concerns.

The TPAC now has a subcommittee that is developing a data-driven process for making ongoing adjustments to on-street parking in the district. The subcommittee will also develop a Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Plan to help reduce some of the overall competition for on-street parking in the area.

What should I know about the kinds of decisions the TPAC subcommittee will be making?

The subcommittee's work includes determining how and where to use parking permits and pay stations to manage parking demand across the district. As part of the process, the subcommittee will decide which kinds of users should have parking priority within the district's industrial and mixed employment zones (i.e. customers, employees). They will also determine priority and demand-based criteria for implementing best practice on-street parking management strategies. In some cases, strategies may include reductions in the overall number of permits available, increases in permit fees, and/or adding new pay stations when on-street parking demand reaches the highest critical thresholds.

What will the decision-making process look like?

The subcommittee will make recommendations to TPAC, which will make recommendations to the CEIC for adoption.

How can I participate and learn more?

For transportation and parking-related issues in the district, TPAC meets on the fourth Wednesday of each month from 4:00 - 5:30 p.m. The CEIC TPAC subcommittee meets on the second Tuesday of each month from 4:00 - 5:30 p.m. Meetings take place at the River East Building: 1515 SE Water Ave. in the 3rd floor Mt. Adams room.
