Your donations will go directly to a veteran family or individual transitioning into housing after weeks, months or even years of living on the streets. Moving from the streets or shelter can be isolating, as veterans settle into their new home. Your donation of household items will show our veterans that the community cares about them and provide those extra niceties that help make a house a home and a veteran feel appreciated. Consider dividing up the list among friends or family or making a giving tree at work.
