This subcommittee model would consist of four subcommittees; Settlement Agreement Subcommittee, Communications and Outreach Subcommittee, Policy Recommendations Subcommittee and a Governance Subcommittee. Below is a general outline of the subcommittee and its goals and objectives.

Settlement Agreement Subcommittee: The goal of the Settlement Agreement Subcommittee will be to ensure PCCEP stays engaged with the objectives of the Settlement Agreement and handle any related business. Their duties would include but not be limited to *reviewing the annual PPB Report*, engaging government partners, ensuring PCCEP met regularly with necessary partners and ultimately met all necessary requirements of the Settlement Agreement.

Communications and Outreach Subcommittee: The goal of the Communications and Outreach Subcommittee will be to engage the greater public with a specific focus on underrepresented communities and communities with historical adverse interactions with the police including but not limited to the mental health, African-American, Latino, youth, and houseless communities. Their duties would include but not be limited to Reviewing the PPB community outreach plan, reviewing surveys that solicit public input and making sure those surveys reached targeted populations effectively, develop and implement an outreach strategy to engage the community on PCCEP issues and ensure diverse attendance at PCCEP meetings.

Policy Recommendations Subcommittee: The goal of the Policy Recommendations Subcommittee (PRS) would be to review PPB policy, receive input from the public on key concerns and desired policies (in coordination with the Communications and Outreach subcommittee), and finally craft and propose detailed and well thought out policies. The policies crafted by the PRS should be measured by their ability to increase the safety of communities and improve trust between the community and PPB.

Governance Subcommittee: The goal of the Governance Subcommittee shall be to handle all governance matters of PCCEP including but not limited to the coordination of alternates, changes to the By Laws, updates of the leadership structure of the Steering Committee, etc.
