February 2021 Procedure- community feedback

Directive 1010.00-Use of Force

1.1. Members shall use de-escalation techniques, ~~when time and circumstances reasonably permit.~~ ***As a first step in all instances.***

1.3. Members shall consider a disengagement plan when the benefits outweigh the risks associated with the call.

~~to be gained by police intervention are clearly outweighed by the risks associated with the call.~~

6.4.1.2 Restricted Uses.

6.4.1.2. 1. Members striking or jabbing with a baton shall not ***deliberately*** target the head or throat, neck, spine, or groin unless deadly force would be authorized.

6.4.2.2. Restricted Uses.

6.4.2.2.1. Members shall no not ***deliberately*** target a subject's head, neck, throat, or groin area, unless deadly force is authorized.

6.4.6. Riot Control Agents or Area Impact Munitions

7. Police Vehicle Intervention Strategies



7.1. Intentional contact between police vehicle and another occupied vehicle shall constitute a use of force *after de escalating techniques have failed.*

8.1. Authorized uses of deadly force

8.2. The member shall give a verbal warning to the subject. ~~if time, safety, and circumstances permit.~~

12. Supervisor Reporting and Investigation.

12.3.1 If a supervisor is involved in the use of force, they shall contact another supervisor to conduct the administrative review of the incident, *and also refer to our civilian oversight agency.*
