	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bureau of Emergency Communications (BOEC) • What a dispatcher's shift looks like depends on the role they are filling, coach(trainer) call taker, etc. • Dispatcher demeanor effect on first responders, and new dispatch system- Pro Q A system. Global system that provides detailed triage that populates the questions the dispatcher asks given the situation. Mult. Co. EMS pushed for City to acquire. • Two weeks of new system. There are some tweaks and updates, learning curve. • Working with Portland Street response. Still educating public on when it is appropriate to use it, but nice new tool.
