



# Public Works Permitting

## Liability Insurance Requirements

Your project is required to have a certificate of liability insurance with an endorsement on file with Public Works Permitting for the duration of your public works permit work. The certificate and endorsement must meet the requirements detailed in this document. The certificate and endorsement must be on file and approved prior to issuance of your permit(s), must be replaced prior to expiring, and must remain in effect for the duration of the permit work. A lapse in coverage or failure to renew coverage can result in the stopping of permit work or revocation of your permit(s).

This document should be provided directly to your insurance agent to aid them in issuing a certificate of liability insurance and endorsement that complies with the City of Portland's insurance requirements for public works permits.

### **CERTIFICATE AND ENDORSEMENT REQUIREMENTS – Both a certificate of liability insurance and an endorsement that meet all of the below requirements must be provided.**

#### **Certificate of Liability Insurance**

- General Liability coverage of a minimum of \$2,000,000 (two million dollars) in aggregate
- General Liability coverage of a minimum of \$1,000,000 (one million dollars) per occurrence
- City of Portland Public Works Permitting named as the certificate holder using the address:

- The description of operations section of the certificate must include the following note, specific to your project:

**All operations of the named insured, including all operations by subcontractors, performed under a public works permits authorized by the City of Portland for Bureau of Transportation Permit Number T##### and Bureau of Environmental Services Permit Number EP### – ProjectName.**

#### **Endorsement**

- CG 20 12 endorsement or an equivalent endorsement
- Names the "City of Portland and its officers, directors, employees, and agents" if the form names the additional insured entity
