

Frequently Asked Questions regarding the Annual Wonder Woman Awards

1. Does every woman who is nominated receive an award?

Yes. Every woman who is nominated and is a City of Portland employee receives a certificate with a special small gift from DEEP.

2. Do you have to be born a woman to qualify?

No. You qualify as a woman if you identify as a woman or womxn, are transgender or non-binary. Nominees must be human though.

3. Do they have to be a full time or permanent employee?

No. They can be part-time, seasonal, contract, etc. As long as they are working for the City of Portland at the time of the awards!

4. How will the nominees know that they are receiving an award?

Debbie Caselton or someone from DEEP will send an outlook meeting invitation to the awardee for the awards ceremony on April 2. It will be titled with the event and that you are an awardee.

5. What if I can't attend the awards ceremony?

Either a co-worker who is attending the awards can bring you your certificate and gift, or DEEP will interoffice it to you the next day or week (depending on volume).

6. Can co-workers or family members attend the awards as well?

Yes! The more the merrier.

7. Can I bring my lunch to this event?

Yes. We couldn't the past couple of years because food wasn't allowed in Council Chambers. But it is allowed in the Portland Building space.

8. Will there be any Exceptional Wonder Womxn Awards given again this year?

Yes.

9. After the awards, how do I get a list of who won at my bureau?
