

## ORDINANCE No.

\*Amend price agreement with Hitachi Vantara LLC for staff technology hardware and services in the amount of \$1,875,000 and extend contract by three years (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 31001759)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) currently contracts with vendor Hitachi Vantara LLC to provide essential storage area network (SAN) hardware, software and services.
2. Contract 31000786 was entered into with Hitachi Data Systems corporation for a contractual total not to exceed \$7,500,000 for the initial term which was December 1, 2015 through November 30, 2020. Amendment 1 documents contract assumption by Hitachi Vantara LLC. With this name change, the contract was renumbered to 31001759 with an effective date of June 10, 2020.
3. This amendment is essential in order for BTS to continue providing ongoing SAN storage to support bureau critical needs. BTS seeks to increase the current contract not-to-exceed amount of \$7,500,000.00 by \$1,875,000.00 to a new total not-to-exceed amount of \$9,375,000.00 and extend the current Term from November 30, 2020 to November 30, 2023, unless terminated sooner under the provision of the Contract. Funds are available.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute the contract amendment, substantially similar to attachment A, provided it is approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to continue work on City technology projects in progress. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council.

OF A HITACHI DATA SYSTEMS CORPORATION STORAGE AREA NETWORK  
AND RELATED PRODUCTS AND SERVICE**

This Amendment No. 2 amends Contract No. 31001759 dated 1st day of December, 2015, by and between Hitachi Vantara LLC ("Contractor" or "Hitachi") a corporation of the State of Delaware, and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon ("City") by and through their duly authorized representatives. This Amendment may refer to Contractor and City individually as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties."

The Effective Date of this Amendment is September 4, 2020. The purpose of this Amendment is to extend the Term and add funds to the Contract.

The Parties agree to Amend the Contract as follows:

1. The Contract not-to-exceed amount of \$7,500,000.00 is increased by **\$1,875,000.00** to a new total not-to-exceed amount of **\$9,375,000.00**.
2. The Term is extended from November 30, 2020 to **November 30, 2023**, unless terminated sooner under the provisions of the Contract.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract remain unchanged by this Amendment and in full force and effect.

**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

The purpose of this legislation is to authorize an amendment to an existing contract for storage area network, hardware, software and services with Hitachi Vantara LLC. The value of the contract will be increased by \$1,875,000; the total revised value of the contract will be \$9,375,000. The term of the contract will be extended by three years.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

BTS has appropriation in their FY 2020-21 budget to cover the anticipated current expense associated with this action. Funding for the out years of this agreement are included in the BTS 5-Year and CIP plans. There are no long term impacts on either revenue or expense.
