



Record Request Reduced Fee/Waiver Application

The Bureau of Development Services will consider reducing or waiving fees associated with Public Records Requests on a case-by-case basis.

A waiver may be available in cases where the Records Requestor has documentation of little or no income or another hardship.

The Records Requestor must submit a completed waiver application and Uniform Records Request Form in order to determine waiver eligibility. They must also provide an explanation, current federal tax return, statement of benefits from a social service agency, or other documentation showing current income. We understand that the information we are requesting may contain confidential information such as your Social Security number. You may redact such information before providing us a copy. The Records Requestor will be notified regarding the waiver application results within 7 business days. However, an exact turnaround time is not guaranteed.
