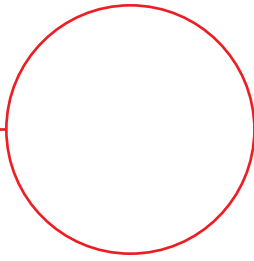
The applicant will be required to certify compliance with regulations governing asbestos and lead-based paint.

Posted notice: At least 35 days before the building permit is issued for the major residential alteration or addition, the applicant must post door hangers provided by BDS on all the properties abutting and across the street from the site of the project. See example Figure below. The notice must contain all of the following information.

- Notice that an application for a major alteration or addition has been or will be submitted to the Bureau of Development Services;
- The permit application number, if an application has already been filed;
- The approximate date the construction activity will commence;
- Contact information of the agencies that regulate asbestos and lead-based paint; and
- Contact information for the applicant.
