Meeting Notice:

Mitch reported requirements for our meeting notices: need to include time and place and be sent to reach those w/ interest in our business, or who have specifically requested notification at least 24 hours prior. Mitch will coordinate w/ BDS staff to make sure this happens. Minutes of prior meeting should be available at time of notification.

Title 28 Amendment Status:

About 75% of Nancy's time has been diverted to the controversy surrounding the City's Demolition Delay Ordinance and tracking the relevant bills being introduced by the current legislature relating to BDS. She will be back on completing the Title 28 changes once she gets out from under these. It was agreed that at that time, she will also get any changes to Multnomah County in connection with their consideration of adopting a form of Title 28.
