On Feb. 1, 2018, the City Council passed a new City ordinance that requires dust and site control measures for demolitions of residential structures with 1-4 units and the accessory structures over 200 square feet on those sites.

Topics to be discussed:

- What residential properties will be affected
- New permitting and inspection requirements
- New demolition permit fees
- Documentation required prior to obtaining a demolition permit
- Asbestos and lead-based-paint certifications required for the person conducting the demolition
- Enforcement associated with the new ordinance
- Implementation timeline
