Re: The City has received an application to correct a minor violation with the removal of unpermitted pavement and replanting of native species within an **environmental zone**. The purpose of this notice is to inform neighbors and interested persons of activities and projects within the environmental zones that will utilize the Environmental Development Standards of Zoning Code Chapter 33.430. This is not a Land Use Review notice.

The application is being reviewed for compliance with the environmental development standards in section 33.430.405.B – Option One, Remove and Repair. This option results in removal of illegal development, replanting, and repair of any damage.

Any interested person may comment on the application by writing and specifically identifying errors or non-compliance with development standards. Comments should be directed to the staff person noted above. Comments may be used to clarify or improve the accuracy of the site plan but may not be used by the City to influence the issuance of a permit for a project that meets development standards. **An inspector will visit the site to verify the accuracy of the site plan prior to issuance of any permits.**
