- Folks can access any number of codes, but the main codes are: Title 10, erosion control; Title 24, Building Regulations (See Chapter 24.50, Flood Hazard Areas); and Title 33, Planning and Zoning. In Title 33, the relevant chapters are 33.430 and 33.440, but there are others that apply.

- They'll need an address to find the property, or know the tax account number for an "advanced" search.
