

ENB – 4.16 Addenda to the Clean River Rewards Discount Program

Section 2. Purpose

~~Reform the way the City pays for street drainage services by relying on charges based on the use of public streets rather than the impervious area of developed property.~~

Section 3 - Definitions

O. Riparian Property means property that discharges stormwater directly into the Willamette River, Columbia River, or Columbia Slough, without use of City stormwater management ~~publicly owned or operated~~ facilities. This definition does not include properties that discharge to any other surface water body, stream, creek or drainage-way.

Section 5. Calculating Discounts

BES will calculate discounts based on the extent and effectiveness of private stormwater management efforts. Two distinct calculation methods are used, one for each class of ratepayer. The total value of full, partial and supplemental discounts will not exceed 100% of the onsite portion of the stormwater management charge. The City will not grant discounts when stormwater is discharged off of the subject property to a City sewer, storm sewer or drainage system.
