## SW 86th Avenue Pump Station Construction Update

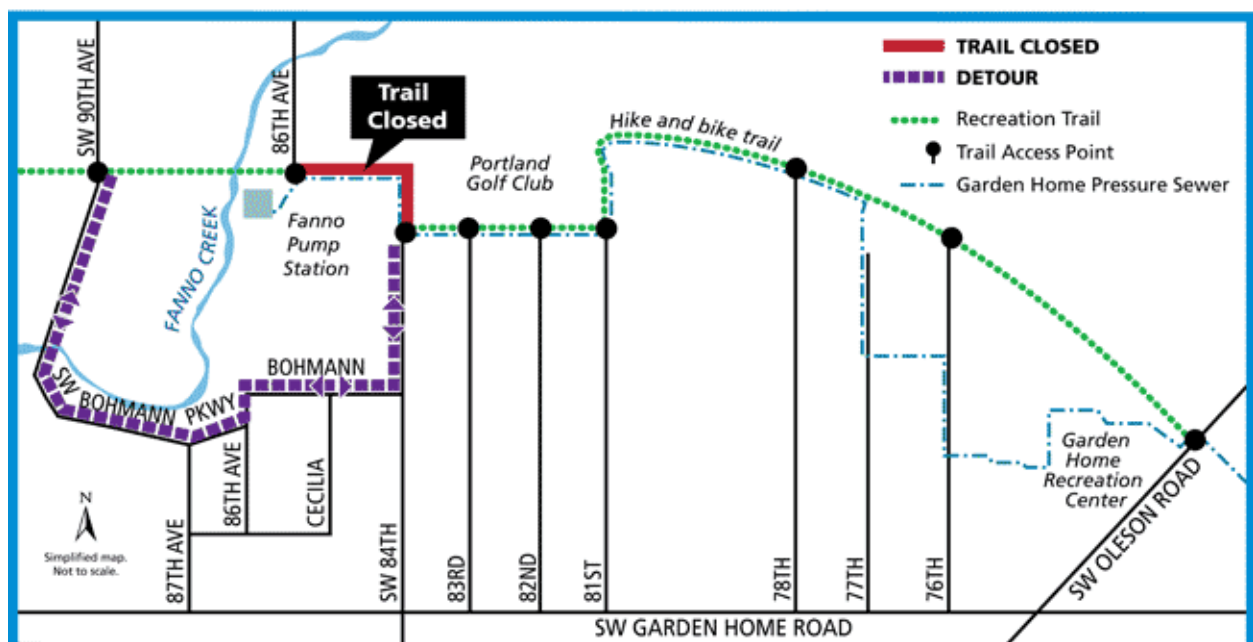

### Developments of Note

- The Fanno Creek Trail will close between SW 86th and SW 84th avenues for up to two weeks starting as soon as Monday, October 26 while work crews connect pipes to the existing pressure sewer line under the trail at SW 84th Avenue.
- The SW 86th Avenue Pump Station project is on schedule and Environmental Services plans to activate the facility this winter. There will be crews and activity on site through next summer finishing restoration and other post-construction activity.
