Portsmouth-University Park Sewer Repair Project Sewer Repairs Being Designed

Environmental Services is designing a project to repair up to 7,700 feet, or almost one and a half miles, of public sewers in the Portsmouth and University Park neighborhoods. Many of the existing sewer pipes are 80 years old and in deteriorating condition. This project is one of many that will protect the public and the environment by reducing the possibility of sewage releases to homes, businesses and streets.

Construction is anticipated to begin in 2018 and will take about a year and a half to complete.

Project Area


The Portsmouth – University Park Sewer Repair Project covers a large area in north Portland. See the back of this flyer for a revised map of pipe repair locations. It has been updated since our first project mailing last year.

Environmental Services is also designing a large sewer repair project in the St. Johns and Cathedral Park neighborhoods (see map at right for both project areas). We will coordinate construction and outreach for both projects.

Sewer construction will occur on N Lombard Street, and there will be construction near several businesses. We will be reaching out to neighbors and businesses soon to better understand business operations and access needs during construction.

What is happening now?

Over the next several months, work crews will be in the neighborhood gathering information to define repair locations, select construction methods and minimize construction impacts on residents and businesses. Crews will survey the neighborhood, access sewers from manholes to inspect pipes and place temporary paint markings on the pavement to mark the locations of pipes and other underground utilities.


Pipe Repair Locations
