## Woodlawn-King Streets Sewer Repair Project Construction Starting Soon

SEPTEMBER 12, 2017

Crews plan to begin construction next week on the Woodlawn-King Streets Sewer Repair Project. While nearby sewer construction in the neighborhood's alleys began this summer, sewer work in the *streets* is scheduled to begin around September 18th, and should take about a year to complete. The first repairs will take place on NE Stafford Street, between NE Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and NE 8th Avenue (see traffic cone on map).

These repairs will help protect the public and our environment by reducing the possibility of costly breaks, leaks, blockages and sewage releases to homes, businesses and streets.


### Construction Schedule

Typical construction hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The contractor may schedule work during the same hours on Saturdays.

## What to Expect during Construction

**Noise, Vibration, and Dust:** Construction creates noise, vibration and dust and may occasionally disrupt normal neighborhood activity.

**Traffic Delays:** Expect traffic delays in and near the work area. Please observe signs and flaggers.

**Driveway Access:** Local access to most properties will be maintained, but construction may impact use of your driveway or entrance to your business.

**Parking Restrictions:** On-street parking will be restricted in and near work zones to create a safe work environment and to stage equipment and materials.


**Equipment Storage:** Some equipment and materials may be stored on streets overnight.

**Maintained Service:** Sewer, water and other utilities will remain in service during construction.
