Program Requirements and Regulations

1. Ratepayers must submit signed registration form to receive discount.
 2. The discount is limited to the on-site stormwater management fee, which is 35% of the basic stormwater fee.
 3. The discount is based on the extent and effectiveness of private onsite stormwater management systems to control the pollution, flow rate and disposal of stormwater runoff from all impervious areas on the property. See the Commercial Calculator on the www.cleanriverrewards.com website for more information.
 4. A site inspection must be completed by Clean River Rewards Program staff before a discount is applied.
 5. The discount is granted to the active ratepayer for the property described on the registration form.
 6. The ratepayer must not have a delinquent city utility account, or must be honoring a payment agreement to eliminate any delinquencies.
 7. The registration form must accurately describe the property and methods for managing stormwater runoff.
 8. The ratepayer must notify Clean River Rewards Program of any changes to property improvements, stormwater facilities or tree canopy that would alter the ratepayer's discount registration.
 9. Stormwater facilities must be properly located, sized, maintained and operating effectively. They must not threaten or cause harm to the subject property, neighboring property, city facilities, or the environment.
 10. The City must be granted access to the property to conduct announced inspections of stormwater management facilities. The City arranges inspections at times that are mutually acceptable to all parties.
 11. To maintain the discount, the utility account must remain active, the stormwater management facilities must be properly maintained and operated, and the City must be granted access to the property to conduct limited inspections of stormwater facilities.
 12. The discount program remains in effect indefinitely until or unless modified by City Council.
 13. The City may impose civil penalties, reverse granted discounts and credits, and revoke future discounts in response to the filing of a fraudulent registration.
