## Single Family Residential Ratepayer Registration Form

### Program Requirements and Regulations

1. Ratepayers must submit a signed registration form to receive a discount.
2. The discount is limited to the on-site stormwater management fee, which is 35% of the basic stormwater fee.
3. The discount is based on controlling stormwater runoff from roof areas, including houses, garages, carports and other storage or utility buildings on the property.
4. The discount is granted to the active ratepayer for the property described on the registration form.
5. The ratepayer must not have a delinquent city utility account, or must be honoring a payment agreement to eliminate any delinquencies.
6. The registration form must accurately describe the property and methods for managing stormwater runoff.
7. The ratepayer must notify the Clean River Rewards Program of any changes to property improvements, stormwater facilities or tree canopy that would alter the ratepayer's discount registration.
8. Stormwater facilities must be properly located, sized, maintained and operating effectively. They must not threaten or cause harm to the subject property, neighboring property, City facilities, or the environment.
9. The City must be granted access to the property to conduct announced inspections of stormwater management facilities. The City arranges inspections at times that are mutually acceptable to all parties.
10. To maintain the discount, the utility account must remain active, the stormwater management facilities must be properly maintained and operated, and the City must be granted access to the property to conduct limited inspections of stormwater facilities.
11. The discount program remains in effect indefinitely until or unless modified by City Council.
12. The City may impose civil penalties, reverse granted discounts and credits, and revoke future discounts in response to the filing of a fraudulent registration.

### Low Income Assistance Program For Utility Ratepayers

The City offers financial assistance to qualified ratepayers. Eligible ratepayers may receive a discount on their utility bill. In addition, eligible ratepayers may receive crisis assistance and help with repairing leaky pipes and fixtures. Eligible low income working families can receive earned income tax credits when filing federal and state tax returns. Portland is working with CASH Oregon (Creating Assets, Savings and Hope) to make sure that every eligible family receives these important financial benefits. From January through April, visit the CASH Oregon tax preparation office at Lloyd Center to get help completing your tax filing. While you are there, look for information about the City's Low Income Assistance Program and Clean River Rewards.
