

Sunnyside East Green Street and Sewer Project Construction to Begin in August



Environmental Services is preparing to begin construction later this summer on the Sunnyside East Green Street and Sewer Project in the Sunnyside Neighborhood to repair, replace, or install 4,800 feet of sewer pipe. Some of the pipe being replaced is 100 years old and deteriorating due to age. Environmental Services will also add 16 green street planters and replace or plant 26 trees to remove 2.4 million gallons of stormwater from sewer pipes. These improvements will protect public health, property and the environment and reduce the possibility of sewage releases into streets, homes and businesses in the Willamette Watershed.



Schedule

Construction is anticipated to begin later in August 2018 and complete in late summer 2019. The Sunnyside North Project adjacent to this project is anticipated to begin construction at the end of this year and completed in the spring of 2020.

Over one-third of Portland's 2,500 miles of sewer pipes are more than 80 years old. Portland combines sewer improvements that replace or repair Portland's aging sewer pipes with green streets, ecoroofs, trees and other green infrastructure to increase sewer system efficiency, and protect water quality, public health, and the environment. Green infrastructure keeps stormwater out of the sewer system, filters pollutants, provides habitat and increases neighborhood green space for healthier watersheds.

What to Expect During Construction

- **Work Site Safety** is our top priority for every construction site. You can help keep the area safe by staying clear of all construction activities and keeping children, pets and vehicles out of construction areas.
- **Noise, Vibration, and Dust** from construction may disrupt normal neighborhood activity.
- **Traffic Delays** should be expected in and near the work area. Please observe traffic control signs and follow the directions of flaggers.
- **Local access** to all properties will be maintained, but construction may impact normal use of your driveway or entrance to your business
- **On-Street Parking** will be restricted in and near the work zones to create a safe work environment and to stage equipment and materials.
- **Equipment Storage:** Some equipment and materials will be stored on your street or nearby streets overnight.
- **Sewer, water, and other utilities** will remain in service during construction.
- **Typical Work Hours** are 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, but the contractor may schedule work during the same hours on Saturdays. Work on SE Cesar E Chavez Boulevard will be performed at night.
- **Schedule Changes and Inactivity** during construction phases can occur due to a variety of factors, including conditions underground, weather, traffic impacts, subcontractor schedules and availability of materials.

Construction Methods

Environmental Services will use an open trench excavation method for the sewer work on this project. Learn more about this method at www.portlandoregon.gov/bes/methods.
