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South Portland-Burlingame Sewer Repair Project – Phase 1 DESIGN UPDATE

Environmental Services, your sewer and stormwater utility, will begin construction in the Fall of 2019 on Phase One of the South Portland-Burlingame Sewer Repair Project. The project will repair or replace approximately 10,800 feet of public sewer pipes throughout your neighborhood. On average, these pipes are 90 years old and in deteriorating condition. Taking these actions now will help protect the public and the environment by reducing the possibility of costly breaks, leaks, blockages and sewage release to homes, businesses and streets.

Schedule

In the next few months, the city will be considering bids for construction and a contractor will be selected. Once a contractor is selected, they will begin developing the overall construction schedule.

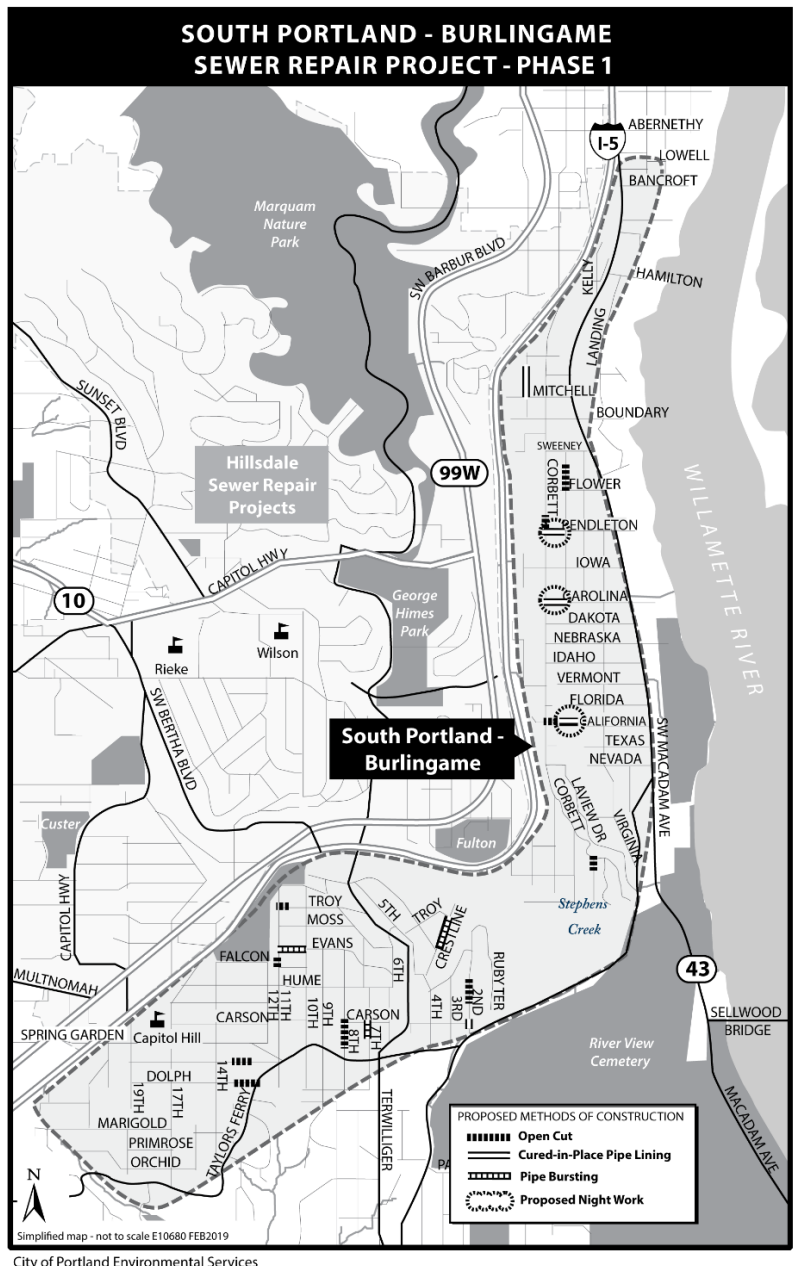
Construction is anticipated to begin in October of 2019 and take a year to complete.

Project Area

The South Portland-Burlingame Project is in one of two phases of sewer repair planned for the area. Environmental Services is in the early stages of planning and design for phase two. A construction date for phase two is not currently known, but it is anticipated that this work will take place following the completion of phase one.

For Phase One, engineers have determined which pipes will be repaired and have also identified construction methods and potential night work locations (see map above). To learn more about these construction methods visit:
