SE Mill Street Sewer Replacement Project Construction to Begin in July

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

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To minimize construction impacts on the public and avoid digging up the street twice, Environmental Services will construct public sewer improvements this summer in advance of the street and stormwater improvements.

The sewer project will replace and upsize 629 feet of public sewer pipes in SE Mill Street between SE 80th and 82nd avenues. The project will also construct two manholes, repair a third manhole, and replace several service laterals that connect private properties to the public sewer. This sewer project will protect public health and the environment by reducing the possibility of sewage releases to buildings and streets.

Location

Sewer construction will occur in SE Mill Street between SE 80th and SE 82nd avenues.



Schedule

Environmental Services will begin constructing public sewer improvements in July and take up to three months to complete the work. The Portland Bureau of Transportation will then construct the street, sidewalk, and stormwater improvements. Environmental Services is currently finalizing design and preparing for the contractor bid and selection process, which will continue into June 2019. When the contract is finalized, the contractor will prepare to mobilize crews for construction. We will notify the public before construction is expected to begin.

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Work Hours Include Night Work in 82nd Ave

General construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday, and Saturday as needed. To minimize traffic impacts, the Portland Noise Office granted Environmental Services a noise variance to work at night in the intersection at SE 82nd Avenue. Night work will be from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m., Monday through Friday, and may last up to two weeks.

Construction Methods

The construction contractor will use open trench excavation to replace mainline sewer pipes, service laterals, and manholes. This method involves excavating down to and exposing the existing pipe so that it can be replaced. For more details and photos about this method, visit www.portlandoregon.gov/bes/opentrench.

After replacing the sewer pipes, crews will backfill the trenches and apply temporary asphalt patches. After all work has passed inspection, crews will return to restore the patched trenches with final paving. Crews will grind down the temporary asphalt patches to remove any cracks, ruts, and imperfections. Then they will place a two-inch layer of asphalt paving on top of the trench surface to fill any holes and level it off. The broad trenches where crews had to dig in the street will have a fresh new asphalt surface.
