Hollywood-Grant Park Phase 2 Sewer Repairs (Project No. E10385)

Advance Notice of Restricted Water Use

Environmental Services will begin construction to repair aging and deteriorating public sewer pipes near your property. Crews will use a process called Cured-in-Place-Pipe Lining (CIPP) to repair the pipes. The repairs will protect public health and the environment by reducing the possibility of sewage releases to houses, businesses, and streets.


Location

The public sewer pipes are located in sewer easements shown on the map. The work to repair these pipes will affect your household.

Beginning at 9 a.m. on

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2019

and continuing until the pipe lining process is completed (perhaps midnight or later), do not flush your toilet or pour water or other liquids down the drain. Otherwise, your property will be at risk of a sewer backup.



Construction Method

The public sewer pipe to be repaired adjacent to your property is several hundred feet long and in shallow ground. Therefore, the pipe lining process to repair it will take a full day, and the curing process to harden the liner inside the pipe will last until midnight or later. The pipe lining process must be done when the pipe is dry and sewage, stormwater, or rainwater is not flowing into the pipe. Due to the shallow position of the pipe underground, a bypass system cannot be set up to provide use of your private sewer and drainage systems during this repair work.

Schedule

Crews will be on-site at 7 a.m. to set up their work. The pipe lining process will begin two to four hours after setup and will last until midnight or later. **Do not flush your toilet or pour water or other liquids down the drain during the pipe lining process.** The Portland Noise Office has granted this project a noise variance for crews to work beyond 6 p.m. and overnight to complete the sewer repairs. If this work must be cancelled due to rain or other factors, we will notify you.

Restricted Water Use

To avoid water and sewage filling up your private sewer and backing up into your home or business, we ask that you restrict your water use or avoid water use altogether during the work. Environmental Services asks for your cooperation in the following ways:

- Be prepared to stop water use at 9 a.m. on the date indicated above.
- Do not flush your toilet.
- Do not pour water or other liquids down the drain.
- Do not take showers or baths. Do not wash clothes or dishes.
- Do not use appliances that generate wastewater, such as dishwashers and washing machines.
- Your tap water will still be drinkable. You may run water into a glass, pitcher, or other container, but do not run or pour water or other liquids down the drain.
- Also, please turn off all sump pumps that are connected to the sewer, and shut off any irrigation systems that may lead to water entering the storm drain.

Accommodations to Manage Restricted Water Use

Environmental Services understands that asking you not to run water or flush toilets during the pipe lining process is a major inconvenience and disruption to your daily lives. Therefore, **we are offering two different options to provide accommodations during the one-day and nighttime pipe repair that will impact your household.** Please consider the following options and let us know right away which option you prefer:

1. **Porta Potty** – If you would like to stay in your home during the pipe lining process, we can provide you a Porta Potty with a padlock to be stationed outside your house or business. With this option, we still ask that you restrict your water use as explained above. But you will have the use of a Porta Potty instead of your toilet.
2. **Overnight Lodging** – If you would like to leave your home during the pipe lining process, we can offer your household a sum of \$250 to help defray the costs of hotel accommodation, meals, and other related expenses. If you select this option, we will mail you a check in the amount of \$250 after the pipe lining process is completed. You do not need to provide receipts, except for cancellation charges that are a result of the Montavilla North / Hollywood-Grant Park Phase Two sewer project.

Please select only ONE of the following options, fill in your full name, property address, and contact information, sign and date, and return this entire notice to us either by email as a scanned PDF or photo, or use the enclosed self-addressed, stamped envelope by **Friday, Sept. 27, 2019**. Please be sure to provide both your phone and email so we can notify you quickly about the construction schedule.

I would like to have a standard Porta Potty stationed outside my home during the pipe lining process. The City's contractor will set it up and remove it at no expense to me.

I would like to have a wheelchair-accessible Porta Potty stationed outside my home during the pipe lining process. The City's contractor will set it up and remove it at no expense to me.

-OR-

I would like to receive a check in the amount of \$250 after the pipe lining process is completed to be applied towards my household's hotel accommodation, meals, and other related expenses. The City is not responsible for making or cancelling reservations. If the schedule changes and I incur non-refundable hotel cancellation charges as a result of the sewer construction project, I will submit receipts for reimbursement.
