

## Report of Income from Additional Employers or Pensions/Annuity or Retirement

The Work Share Program requires the City of Portland to report any additional wages or income you may earn from an employer other than the City of Portland or any income you may have from pension, annuity or retirement pay.

- If you do not have any income from another employer or any income from pension, annuity or retirement pay, you only need to fill out this form once, and submit it with your Work Share Initial Claim Form. Note that if in the future, you receive any income from another employer or from pension, annuity or retirement pay not claimed on your initial submission, you will need to submit this form again to report that income.
- If you have income from another employer or any income from pension, annuity or retirement pay, and the amount of that income is the same every week, you only need to fill out this form once, and submit it with your Work Share Initial Claim Form.
- If you have income from another employer or any income from pension, annuity or retirement pay, and the amount of that income is different every week, you need to fill out this form and submit it every week that a Work Share claim will be filed for you because you had a reduced schedule due to furlough.
