

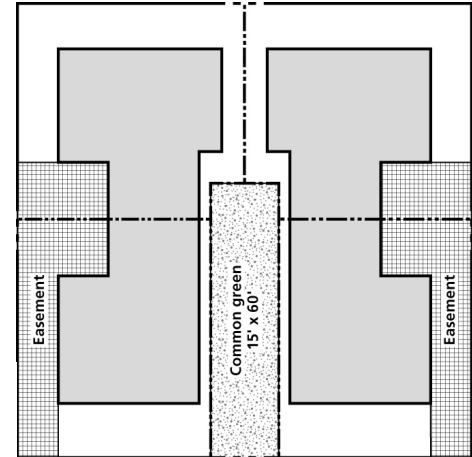
Living Spaces: A Design Competition for Family-Friendly Courtyard Housing

Examples of common green housing

Common Greens:

Housing units on separate lots front onto a landscaped courtyard, or “common green,” that serves as a pedestrian “street” providing access to units. Common greens are also intended to serve as a shared open space amenity for residents. Vehicle access is not allowed across a common green. Instead, access to off-street parking is typically provided by rear alleys or driveways.
