General Information



The Planning and Sustainability Commission (PSC) is responsible for the stewardship, development and maintenance of the City's Comprehensive Plan, Climate Action Plan and Zoning Code. The commission is committed to effective public involvement and leadership in its work and in the decisions it considers.

The Planning and Sustainability Commission (PSC) includes 11 volunteer members with expertise in a range of areas. Their major role is to advise City Council on Portland's long-range goals, policies and programs for land use, planning and sustainability. They do that by holding public hearings and discussing issues and proposals.

The PSC's charge is to act for the benefit of the people of Portland and to make recommendations they think will make Portland a better city. As a group, they have a variety of viewpoints, and together they balance a variety of City goals, including some that conflict.

The work of the PSC is to:

- Advise City Council and City bureaus on social, economic and environmental issues as well as long-range development in Portland.
- Advise City Council on the development and maintenance of the City's Comprehensive Plan and implementation measures.
- Ensure sustainability principles and practices are integrated into policy, planning and development decisions.
- Advise City Council, as well as City bureaus and other agencies, on projects and proposals that significantly affect the city.

Regular meeting schedule

Unless otherwise notified, the PSC meets regularly at 1900 SW 4th Avenue, Room 2500A, second floor:

- Second Tuesday of each month, 12:30 p.m.
- Fourth Tuesday of each month, 5 p.m.

Submitting Testimony to the PSC

When making a recommendation to City Council, the PSC looks at the material presented by staff and considers all testimony — whether given verbally in person or in writing by letter or email. Testifiers may mail, fax or email their testimony to the commission coordinator before the meeting or give the written testimony to the coordinator at the meeting. If you bring written testimony to the meeting, provide 1 copy of the statement to the Commission Coordinator, who sits at the side of the Commission table.

To ensure commissioners have ample time to consider your testimony, please consider submitting it at least 24 hours in advance of the hearing.• People who wish to speak to the commission directly should attend the designated meeting and complete and submit a testimony card to the commission coordinator. The coordinator accepts cards before and during the meeting until the Commission Chair closes the hearing. (See Tips for Effective Testimony for more detailed instructions.)
