## Commentary

## 33.515.260

This minor code amendment updates trail terminology to recognize that major public trails that are shown on the Official Zoning Maps are used for multiple purposes including transportation corridors for pedestrians and bicyclists. This term is also used in City Council's recently adopted 2035 Comprehensive Plan.

## 33.515.260 Major Public Recreational Trails

- A. <u>Major p Public recreational</u> trail requirements. All sites with a <u>major public recreational</u> trail symbol shown on the Official Zoning Maps must comply with the requirements of Chapter 33.272, <u>Major Public Recreational Trails</u>, except those in the Columbia South Shore Slough Trail area or Cross-Levee Trail area. Sites in these areas, shown on Map 515-4, must also comply with the regulations of this section. If the trail is located within the Environmental zones, the trail must also comply with those requirements.
