**Renewable Fuel Standard – Title 16**

**Part 3, Definitions**

10) "E10" means a fuel mixture of 10% by volume of ethanol and 90% by volume of gasoline, ~~meeting the ASTM D 4814 standard specification for gasoline base stock from which a gasoline-ethanol blend was produced.~~

12) "Ethanol" also known as "Denatured Fuel Ethanol", means nominally anhydrous ethyl alcohol suitable for blending with gasoline, ~~meeting ASTM D 4806 standards. It is intended to be blended with gasoline for use as a fuel in a spark-ignition internal combustion engine. The denatured fuel ethanol is first made unfit for drinking by the addition of Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau approved substances before blending with gasoline.~~
