

**City of Portland, Cannabis Tax Allocation Awardees, for
Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-2018**

After careful review and consideration of each application, The City of Portland is pleased to announce the recipients for funding under The Cannabis Tax Allocation Program for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

Green Hop LLC	Green Hop cannabis workforce incubator	Workforce Development: The project is an intentional effort to racially diversify the cannabis industry with an accelerated training and apprenticeship academy that connects historically underserved populations with the knowledge of how to enter the cannabis industry - from seed to sale.	\$95,155.
Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center + Rosemary Anderson High School	Construction pre-apprenticeship program for communities of color & low-income young adults	Workforce Development: Focused outreach and recruitment to individuals disproportionately impacted by former cannabis laws. Providing training in construction to young adults, with the emphasis of increasing the number of youth and young adults with living-wage professional construction careers.	\$100,000.
Metropolitan Public Defender	Clearing the record of every person with marijuana charges in the City of Portland	Record Clearing: This project would expand Legal Services Day to find and clear the records for anyone in the city of Portland with a marijuana charge on their record.	*\$154,000.

***An additional \$22,186 was awarded to the original award of \$131,814 for outreach to gain access to a wider cross-section of the population to better serve those disproportionately affected by marijuana-related arrests and prosecutions.**

The cannabis committee, which comprised of representatives from the Mayor's office, from each City Commissioner's office, City Procurement Services, and the Office of Equity and Human Rights, reviewed 9 applications totaling \$950,490 in requests, for the two different funding categories: Workforce Development and Record Clearing.
