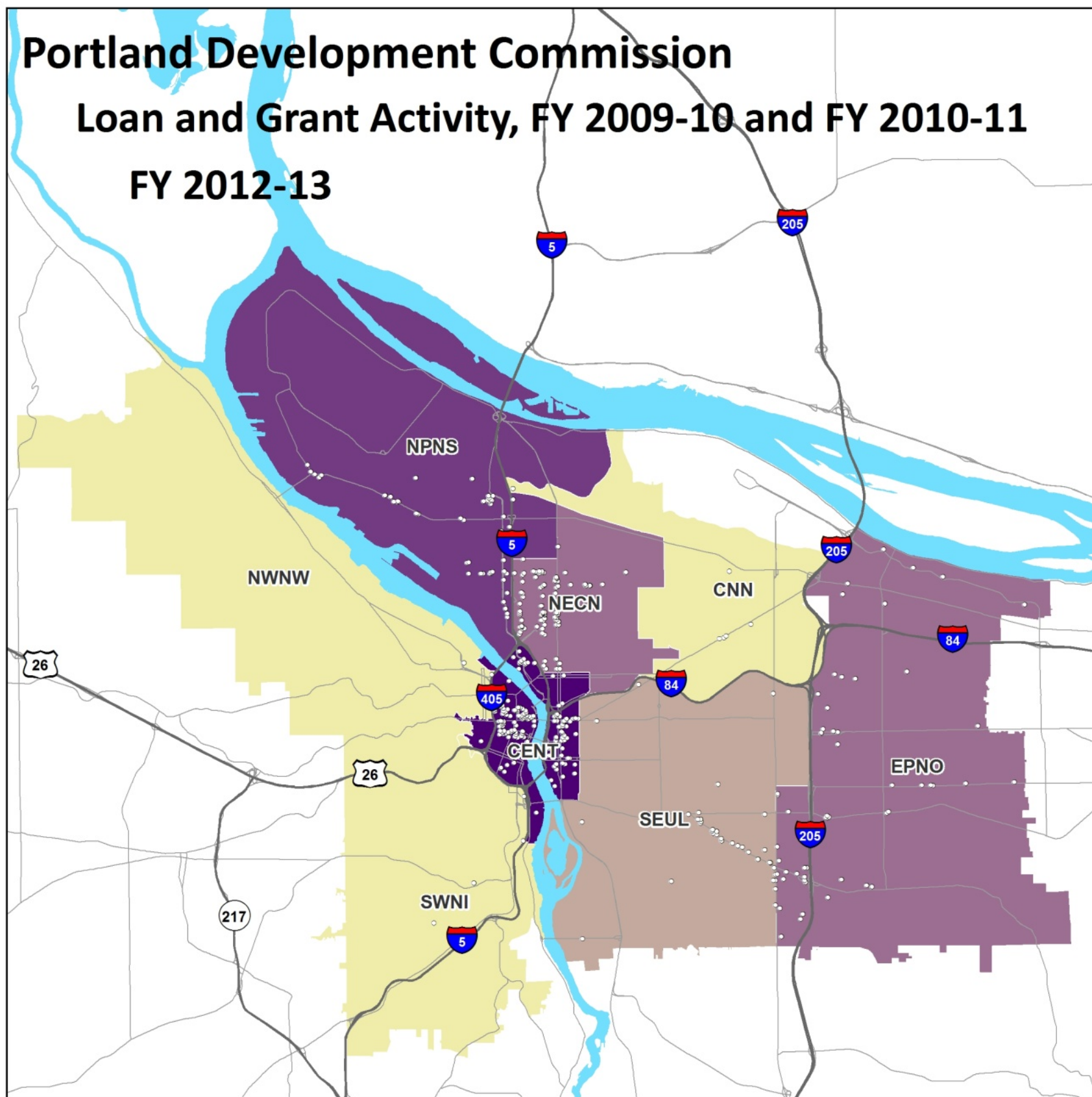

PDC Activity FY 2009-10 – FY 2010-11

The Portland Development Commission connects people and resources to create more jobs for Portland. We work with Portland businesses to identify business needs and eligibility for PDC assistance, and then help you find the program that fits best.

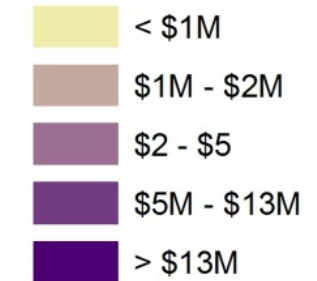
This map represents the total amount of loans and grants that PDC disbursed by Neighborhood Coalition in FY 2009-10 and FY 2010-11. This is the same timeframe used in the accompanying map – 2009-2011 Employment Change.

Total financial assistance by Neighborhood Coalition was \$44,712,703. The majority of funding is from Portland's Urban Renewal Areas - \$41,726,272 (93.3%). Additionally the City General Fund contributed \$1,970,571 (4.4%). The remaining amount is comprised of Enterprise revolving loan funds.

In general, PDC business finance programs address the need for:

- Tenant improvements
- Equipment purchase
- Facade improvements
- Property development & rehabilitation
- Real estate acquisition
- Credit enhancement
- Property feasibility study
- Working capital
