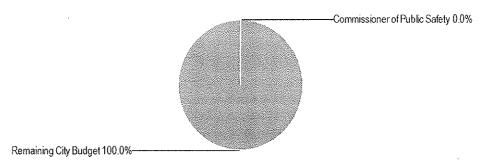

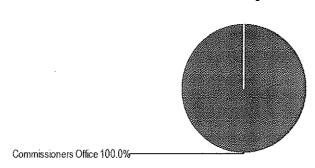

Bureau Summary

Overview

The Commissioner of Public Safety is charged with legislative and administrative responsibilities in accordance with the provisions of the City of Portland Charter. The Commissioner is one of five nonpartisan City Council members. As a whole, the Council promotes a livable and sustainable city by enacting and enforcing City laws, approving a budget, and advocating for policy changes and funding at the state and federal levels. The Commissioner also provides leadership and management oversight for a portfolio of City bureaus.

Bureau Assignments

The Commissioner of Public Safety is responsible for the following bureaus:

- Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT): The Portland Bureau of Transportation is a community partner in shaping a livable city. PBOT plans, builds, manages and maintains an effective and safe transportation system that provides people and business access and mobility.
- Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM): The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management serves in a coordination role with every Bureau and Office in the City. Their mission is to protect lives, the environment, and property through an effective emergency management program. PBEM assists City Bureaus and Offices to prepare, respond, and recover from major disasters.
- Bureau of Emergency Communications (BOEC): BOEC is the vital connection between community and emergency service responders by answering 9-1-1 and non-emergency public safety calls, triaging for proper response, and dispatching appropriate resources throughout Multnomah County.

- Southwest Corridor Plan Steering Committee
- Regional Emergency Management Group

Summary of Budget Decisions

Stabilization Budget

Under the stabilization budget, General Fund bureaus are not required to prepare reduction packages or undergo a modified zero-based budget approach, but instead should submit their requested budgets at the Current Appropriation Level (CAL). The Commissioner of Public Safety's budget reflects this approach.

Council Budget Allocation

The General Fund allocation to all Council Offices has been equalized with a base of \$926,337 for each office in FY 2014-15.
