Key Issues

Budget Summary

The Commissioner of Public Affairs' budget includes administration of the elected official's office, staff for the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services, and administration and grant funding for the Portland Children's Levy (see breakout of total budget and FTE below). The Portland Children's Levy is expected to generate about \$2 million more in tax revenues in FY 2014-15 than it did in FY 2013-14. In addition, current spending in FY 2013-14 is projected to generate an additional \$1 million in beginning fund balance. These additional resources are budgeted as contingency and additional grants (external materials and services) in FY 2014-15.
