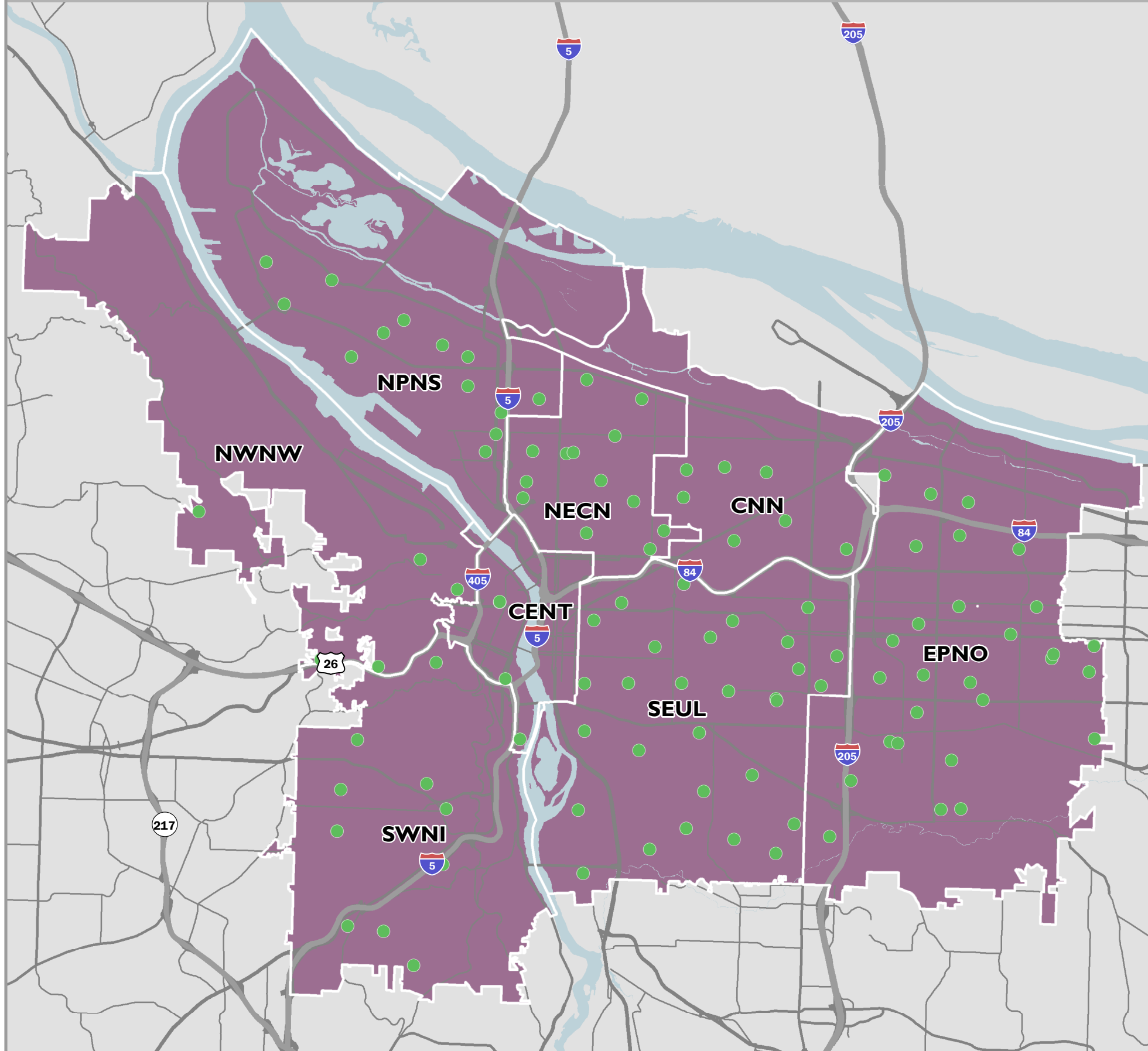

Safe Routes to School is a partnership of the City of Portland, schools, neighborhoods, community organizations and agencies that works to make walking and biking around schools safe and healthy for all students and families.

The Portland Bureau of Transportation's Safe Routes to School program began with eight partner schools in 2005, designed to combat a national trend of fewer and fewer students going to school on foot or by bike. Since then, the program has grown to serve more than 100 schools serving K-to-8th grade students. Services include bicycle and pedestrian safety education in the classroom, traffic safety, and infrastructure assessments and improvements. The program seeks to reach all Portland students with its education programs and to reduce barriers to walking and biking to schools throughout the city. The Safe Routes program currently serves every public elementary, middle, and K-8 school in the city. Since the program began, the percentage of walking or biking trips to school has grown 35 percent.

The program currently does not serve high schools due to constrained funding.
