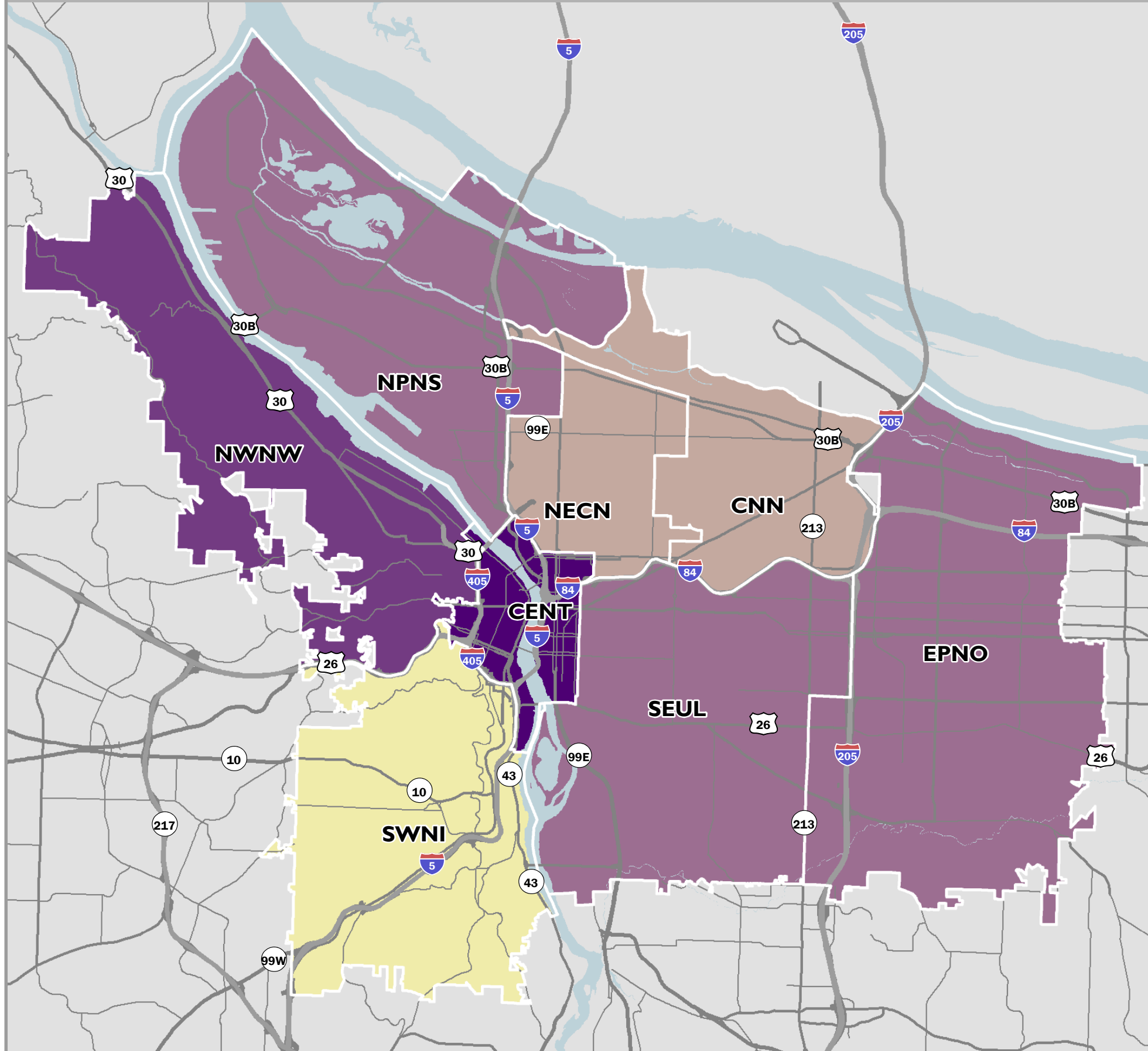


PART I CRIMES PER 1,000 RESIDENTS JULY 1, 2014 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015

BUREAU NOTES

Portland Police Bureau

The Portland Police Bureau (PPB) serves the residents and business community of Portland. PPB uses a three precinct configuration (Central, East, and North). In the adopted FY 2015-16 budget there are 1,188 full-time positions. The budget for sworn positions includes 657 Police Officers and 135 Police Sergeants.

Level of Service

More than 30,000 Part I crimes are reported each year. In FY 2014-15 the rate was 59 Part I crimes per 1,000 residents. The majority (92%) of reported Part I crimes were property offenses, most of which were larcenies. The Part I larceny rate was 41 crimes per 1,000 residents in FY 2014-15. The property crime rate increased slightly over the prior fiscal year, while the person crime rate remained stable.

Map Explanation

Crime rate is based on residential population only and does not account for the influence of non-residential populations such as the workforce. The crime rate in areas of the city that are considered economic and transportation hubs, such as Central City (CENT), may be impacted by these non-residential populations.

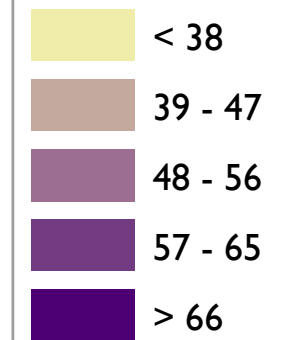
Information Source

Part I crime classification is based on the national standard established by the FBI for the Uniform Crime Reporting Program. Part I person crime includes murder, rape, robbery, and aggravated assault; Part I property crime includes burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft, and arson. The data represent the most serious Part I crime per case.

Citywide numbers include crimes reported to PPB where an exact location was not available. For example, a child reports being a victim of a crime but is not sure of the location. The 8 geographic populations are 2015 estimates from the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability.
